A second PDF may be uploaded if necessary. For media or interactive works, please provide screenshots and/or links for online viewing.

Three letters of recommendation, requested from teachers or professional contacts, organized in Slideroom. Place additional documents listed above at the beginning of a multipage PDF, followed by your portfolio work. Do not send by E-mail, use Slideroom.

If accepted by HGK Basel, you'll proceed with an online application for registration with UIC.

This requires official university transcripts (translated if necessary) and TOEFL/IELTS proficiency tests in English.
